

## **STANDARDIZED TESTING PROGRAM**

Standardized tests administered at Beaches Chapel School are:

### **MAP Growth Testing**

Beaches Chapel School utilizes **MAP** online assessment for grades K-12. This untimed test is designed to be administered three times a year: fall, winter and spring. These tests measure Reading, Math and Language skills and are unique in that they adapt to the child's learning level. The questions and difficulty level adjust to create a personalized assessment experience. This test assists us to use the data to differentiate instruction, set goals and establish a culture of data use.

### **PSAT/NMSQT**

The **PSAT** is administered in October to sophomores for a Pre SAT testing experience. Juniors are also tested each year to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship. The test results and exam booklets are returned to the students and they are taught how to read the results, improve their scores and use as a study tool for college admissions tests (SAT and ACT).

### **Advanced Placement**

**AP** (Advanced Placement) exams are administered each year in May. Students taking advanced placement classes are **REQUIRED** to take the AP exam. To fully prepare for these exams, students work with their teachers in special sessions on weekends. ### **ACT/SAT College Entrance Exams**

Beaches Chapel School does not offer the SAT or ACT testing on our school campus. These college entrance exams are offered throughout the school year on Saturdays at other public and private schools in Jacksonville. Beaches Chapel School's **CEEB code is 102368**. This number is used on their registration to identify the school to which test scores should be sent.
